
FOL Spring Book Sale Fri.-Sat., April 26-27, 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

KY Chautauqua Presents Roscoe Tarleton Goose: Kentucky Derby Winner Tuesday, April 30, 6:00 PM

In what was a stunning victory, Roscoe Tarleton Goose and Donerail won the 1913 Kentucky Derby. The race odds were set at 91:1; the longest odds of a Derby winner, a record which still stands. Goose's story is one of determination, overcoming obstacles, and breaking down barriers. Roscoe Tarleton Goose is portrayed by Eddie Price of Hawesville. Kentucky Chautauqua is an exclusive presentation of Kentucky Humanities with support from the National Endowment for the Humanities and from: Christina Lee Brown, the Carson-Myre Charitable Foundation, and PNC.
